




THIS RANGE HAS BEEN DEVISED TO MEET FARMERS' NEEDS AS CLOSELY AS POSSIBLE.





The cattle arrive from a cattle crowd gate or directly from a 1/2 Corral pen and are pushed towards a chicane followed by the restraint handling race, generally with a cattle crush at the end.





- Support cart with push barrier on rolling path
- Lateral and linear guiding of cart by 8 rollers
- Automatic safety lock
- Secured double operating direction (animal entry or exit)







## 1/2 CORRAL HANDLING ON PLATFORM FOR ANIMALS TO MOVE FORWARD:

- Sheeted contention barrier with clockwise or anticlockwise rotation
- Latch lock
- Double AUTOLOCK lever on a portion of the 1/2 Corral

## THE STRAIGHT EXIT IS INSTALLED AFTER THE 1/2 CORRAL:

- Fixed metal gate
- Sectional gate giving the farmer rapid access to the restraint handling race

# RESTRAINT HANDLING RACE TO GUIDE ANIMALS IN COMPLETE SAFETY:

- Available in fixed or adjustable width versions (46 to 80 cm)
- One side equipped with walkway
- Folding rail (2 handles),
  Clear access above the animals

#### 3-WAY SORTING GATE:

2 fixed cord-operated metal gates enabling animals to be sent to the left or the right.
