To limit waste, two flaps have been added which can be opened during filling, serving as funnels to limit feed waste and ensure effective bucket filling.

These two filling flaps can be purchased separately to ensure easy assembly on your older feeder models. You can benefit from this new feature without having to invest into completely new equipment.

Our latest innovation is designed to meet the needs of your nursery with unequalled practicality. Whether in single or dual version, our pens can be fitted with castors for optimum mobility. They are perfectly suited for hosting calves up to six weeks of age.


You can also decide to lay them on the ground. Each unit comprises a complete initial pen, which can be expanded by means of extensions creating additional spaces.

Our carefully built pens feature three panels in virgin polypropylene for total sealing. Two of these panels form the sides, but they can also be removed to create a configuration for two calves while one rear panel remains fixed.

The façade remains easily accessible by means of a locking pin. It is fitted with two manual headlocks to control access. Fitted with two 28.5 cm diameter folding bucket holders, our pens are supplied with two buckets, to which an optional suckling bucket can be added. This product features our patented slip-proof slats, raising by a joint fastened to the wall.




EX 2 BARRIER

The front barrier features an AUTOLOCK built into the rail. The front square is drilled to be fitted with the adaptation plates (SAC552). This feature enables this barrier to be fitted as a panel for free-service use for calves.


The rear section is designed to be fitted with a lug rod for a height adjustment, guaranteeing optimum operation of the barrier. This feature enables the barrier to be slammed thanks to our market-acknowledged patented SURLOCK bracket.

SEMI-BARRED FIXED FIELD BARRIER


OPTIMUM PROTECTION

Our new range of fixed field barriers 50 x 50 mm meshed bars to prevent young animals, mainly lambs and goats, from crossing the barrier.

Each barrier includes an AUTOLOCK. Use a padlock to prevent the barrier from being opened for additional peace of mind and protect your pens.

Designed to last, this fixed field barrier is not adjustable and requires posts to be anchored in the presence of the barrier. The dimensions correspond to axis/post axis lengths of 102 mm.
